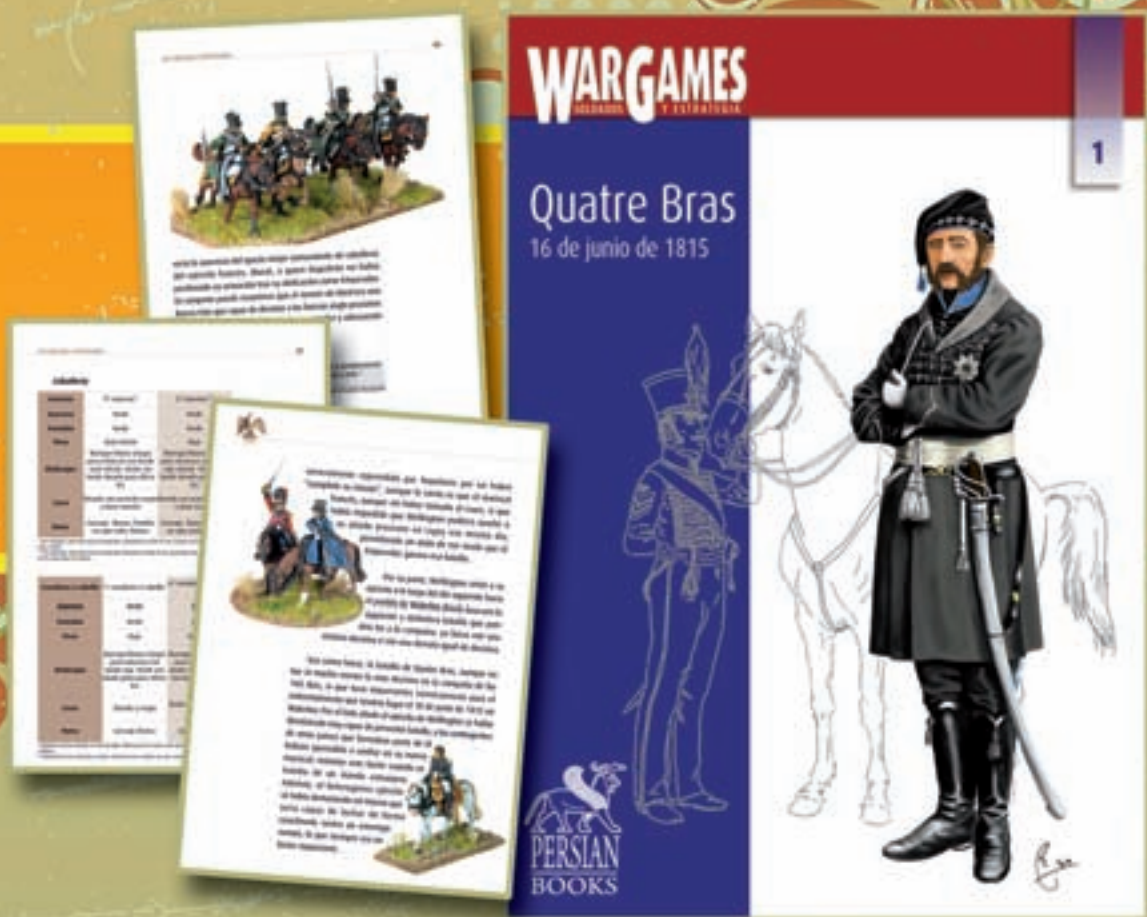

## Warfare - 20th & 21st November 2009



Warfare 2009 was held again this year by Wargames Association of Reading at the Rivermead Leisure complex in Reading. It is the Reading club's annual show and stands as one of the major shows on the UK circuit.

Warfare is an interesting show, providing a bit of everything. There's two days of gaming competition, a large variety of Traders, display games and the 'bring & buy'. Also in attendance were various societies, including the Lance & Longbow society and the Society of Ancients.

Entry to the event was £4 per day with children under 14 going free (a good idea, making the show family friendly).

In addition there was a small fee for parking in the Leisure Centre car park, which was very busy from the outset.

The venue is divided into sections. There's two main sports halls, one for traders and the other for the competition and club games, complete with various side rooms for more competition games and the bring & buy.

In the first hall were the traders. With 72 traders in total, there was a large selection of choice with pretty much every scale and period. Such a good selection of traders is hard to find outside of the larger shows like Salute.

The second hall and side rooms housed the dozen of competition games running over both days. Amongst the competitions were WRG 6th Edition, DBMM, Flames of War, Warhammer 40K, Field of Glory, Warhammer Ancient Bat-
