First Release - ACW 1 Hard Plastic Infantry

Each box contains 36 infantry figures in shell jackets and sack coats with a choice of 36 slouch hats and 36 forage caps. The hats are separate to enable you to build armies of your choice.

The poses are split between marching and firing line, plus command. There is also a choice of four flags and an introductory set of rules for beginners.

These figures are injection moulded hard plastic which, once assembled, require no prepping before painting. Unlike soft plastic figures, paint will not flake off.

The infantry boxed set will shortly be followed by a plastic cavalry boxed set and the start of a metal range.
